Ray, learned advocate for the State respondent.</p> <p>The main grievance of the applicant is that the result of the selection process was not displayed properly and system of awarding marks was not in order. Perusing paragraph 10 of the reply, we find that the results were published in the website of the Police as well as of the Excise Department. From paragraph 12 of the said reply we find that the applicant Subhendu Chowdhury under OBC-B (Male) category, had obtained 66.125 marks, whereas the last selected candidate in the OBC-B (Male) category had obtained 66.75 marks. Therefore, it appears that the applicant had secured lesser marks in his category compared to the last selected candidate and thus he was not selected, which is not disputed in the rejoinder.
