The applicants have prayed for quashing of the order dated May 22, 2014 passed by the Director of Health Services, Government of West Bengal and communicated to one of the applicants by the Joint Director (Personnel), Directorate of Health Services, Government of West Bengal under letter dated May 29, 2014 (annexure 'H' to the original application). *The contention of the applicants is that they joined in* the post of Health Assistant (Female) in different places of State of West Bengal in terms of the order dated December 29, 2008 issued by the Director of Health Services, Government of West Bengal. The further contention of the applicants is that they submitted application before the Deputy Director of Health Services (Nursing) through Proper Channel for appointment to the post of Staff Nurse, Grade II in response to the notice dated August 16, 2012 issued by the Deputy Director of Health Services (Nursing), Government of West Bengal being modified by addendum dated August 29, 2012 issued by the Deputy Director of Health Services

	to the post of Staff Nurse, Grade II were not considered by	
	the authority concerned, the applicants approached the	
	Tribunal by filing OA-1028/2013, which was disposed of	
	on October 28, 2013 by directing the respondents of the	
	said original application to consider the prayer of the	
	applicants for appointment to the post of Staff Nurse,	
	Grade II in terms of notice dated August 16, 2012 by	
	passing a reasoned order. The reasoned order passed by	
	the Director of Health Services, Government of West	
	Bengal in terms of the direction given by the Tribunal in	
	OA-1028/2013 is under challenge in the present	
	application.	
	Learned Counsel for the applicant contends that the	
	applicants have the right to get promotion from Staff	
	Nurse, Grade III to Staff Nurse, Grade II in terms of	
	circular dated April 23, 2010 issued by the Director of	
	Health Services, Government of West Bengal. The	
	applicants have miserably failed to establish before the	
	Tribunal by producing any document that they have been	
	working as Staff Nurse, Grade III. In the absence of any	
	document to establish that the applicants have been	
	working as Staff Nurse, Grade III, we are unable to accept	
	the contention made on behalf of the applicants that they	
	have a right to be considered for promotion to Staff Nurse,	
	Grade II in terms of circular dated April 23, 2010 issued

	that the applicants have the right to be appointed as Staff	
	Nurse, Grade II in terms of notice dated August 16, 2012	
	being modified by addendum dated August 25, 2012. On	
	perusal of notice dated August 16, 2012 and addendum	
	dated August 21, 2012 issued by the Deputy Director of	
	Health Services (Nursing) we find that the said Deputy	
	Director of Health Services (Nursing) invited applications	
	from G.N.M. passed candidates working as Health	
	Assistant (Female) in different Health Institutions for	
	appointment as Staff Nurse, Grade II in different Health	
	facilities of the State of West Bengal. On our query,	
	Learned Counsel for the applicants has frankly submitted	
	that there is no rule for promotion from the post of Health	
	Assistant (Female) to the post of Staff Nurse, Grade II. In	
	the absence of existence of any recruitment rules or	
	administrative direction in the form of G.O. laying down	
	the provisions for promotion from the post of Health	
	Assistant (Female) to the post of Staff Nurse, Grade II, the	
	State of West Bengal can lay down the policy either to fill	
	up the post of Staff Nurse, Grade II directly by publication	
	of advertisement in the newspaper or from the employees	
	working as Health Assistant (Female). The reasoned order	
	passed by the Director of Health Services on May 22,	
	2014 indicates that there was no administrative exigency

	production of any recruitment rules in this regard, this	
	policy decision of the State of West Bengal cannot be	
	construed as arbitrary or illegal. Since there is no	
	promotional avenue from the post of Health Assistant	
	(Female) to the post of Staff Nurse, Grade II, the	
	applicants have no right to claim for consideration for	
	appointment to the post of Staff Nurse, Grade II as	
	contended on behalf of the applicants.	
	Learned Counsel representing the state respondents	
	has supported the reasoned order under challenge in the	
	present application. In view of our above findings, we do	
	not find any merit in the present application. As a result,	
	the present application is dismissed.
