With the above factual matrix, Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is entitled to get House Rent Allowance at par with the employees working in the establishment of the respondent no. 5. On the other hand, Learned Counsel representing the state respondents submits that the quarter no. 10 was allotted in favour of the applicant after her joining at Joypur Block Primary Health Centre on March 04, 2008. He further submits that at present the applicant is posted at Uttarbar Primary Health Centre under Joypur Block Primary Health Centre, Bankura which is situated at a distance of about 22 k.m. from Joypur Block Primary Health Centre.

Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties, we are of the view that the respondent no. 4 should consider the representation submitted by the applicant for deciding whether the applicant is entitled to get House Rent Allowance for not occupying government quarters which, according to the applicant, is not fit for occupation.

Accordingly, the respondent no. 4, Chief Medical Officer of Health, Bankura is directed to consider the representation submitted by the applicant on March 08, 2014 (page 26 to the original application) and decide
