It appears from the impugned order of transfer that she was deemed to have been released with effect from 24th January, 2017 and it was issued in the interest of public service. The impugned order also shows that the posting was temporary. Though it appears that it was issued in the interest of public service no reason has been given.</p> <p>In our view, since no reason has been given in the impugned order of transfer that why it was issued within a span of eight months, the order of transfer under challenge cannot be sustained and is thus set aside and quashed. Moreover since in spite of opportunity no reply has been filed by the respondents, the statements made in the application have gone uncontroverted.
