Mr. Banerjee, Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant will retire from service on October 31, 2020 and as such the period of absence from duty needs to be regularised on an urgent basis for getting benefit of service by the applicant. On the other hand, Mr. Ghosh, Learned Counsel representing the state respondents submits that he has no objection if the respondent no. 2 considers the representation of the applicant in accordance with law.

Having Heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the materials on record, we are of the view that the respondent no. 1, Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Health & Family Welfare should consider the representation submitted by the applicant before the respondent no. 3 on July 17, 2014 (annexure 'C' to the original application) in accordance with law by passing a reasoned order within specific period of time.
