had approached the Tribunal by filing OA 356 of 2017, whereby the Tribunal directed the respondent no. 4 to take necessary action in terms of the letter issued of Senior Accounts Officer of the Principal Accountant General (A&E), West Bengal, so that the applicant may get family pension without further delay. However, without getting family pension, the applicant had to approach this Tribunal for the second time by filing the present application.

It appears from the materials on record that the applicant has already opened the Saving Bank Account No. 0180010063018 in United Bank of India in the Branch of the respondent no. 4 for the purpose of disbursement of the amount of family pension in her favour. What transpires from the materials on record is that the applicant is entitled to get family pension w.e.f. July 25, 2000 till the date of actual disbursement of family pension by issuance of PPO from the end of respondent no. 3. Naturally, the amount of arrears of family pension need to be disbursed by the order of the respondent no. 2 who happens to be the pension sanctioning authority of the deceased husband of the present applicant.

Under the above circumstances, we direct the respondent no. 2 to take necessary steps for grant of family pension and disbursement of the arrears of family
