	Respondent No.3 requesting him to conduct an enquiry		
	to ascertain the claim of the Respondent No. 6 as the first		
	wife of the deceased employee and for realisation of		
	excess payment made to the applicant, which is under		
	challenge in the present application.		
	By producing record, the authorized		
	representative of the Respondent No. 3 submits that the		
	enquiry has already been conducted in connection with		
	the claim of the Respondent No. 6 and it is found that the		
	Respondent No. 6 is the first legally married wife of		
	Md.Manowar Hossain. Learned Counsel representing		
	the applicant submits that the excess payment already		
	made in favour of the applicant may not be recovered as		
	the said amount has already been spent by the applicant.		
	Learned Counsel representing the Respondent No. 6		
	submits that she may be paid 50 % of the entire amount		
	of arrears of family pension from the date of her		
	entitlement till the date of release of regular family		
	pension.

	On consideration of the above submission made	
	on behalf of the respective parties, we are of the view	
	that both the applicant and the Respondent No.6 are	
	entitled to get family pension in equal half share as per	
	provisions of Rule 104 of the West Bengal Services	
	(Death-cum-Retirement Benefits) Rules, 1971. The	
	Respondent No.3 being the authority to sanction family	
	pension, is duty bound to pass an order declaring	
	payment of family pension in favour of both the	
	applicant and the Respondent No. 6 in equal half share	
	from April 20, 2015. Both the applicant and the	
	Respondent No.6 are entitled to get the entire amount of	
	arrears of family pension which has not been disbursed	
	due to stoppage payment of family pension by the order	
	of Respondent No.2. However, the Respondent No. 3	
	will pass order for realisation of excess payment made in	
	favour of the applicant, so that the Respondent No. 6	
	may get her dues from the arrears of family pension	
	which has not been disbursed till date. We are of the	
	view that the amount of interest should not be realised	
	from the applicant at the time of realisation of excess	
	payment of family pension in favour of the applicant.
