Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the materials on record, we find that the applicant has not produced any document to establish that he rendered temporary service as N.V.F. continuously before his appointment in the post of Constable of Police. Accordingly, the past service rendered by the applicant as member of N.V.F. cannot be taken into consideration for computation of qualifying service for pension. Any government employee must render 10 years of qualifying service for grant of pension as laid down in the provisions of Rule 67 of West Bengal Services (death-cum-retirement benefit) Rules, 1971 (in short, the D.C.R.B. Rules, 1971). In the instant case, the applicant rendered service for total period of 9 years and 11 months and thereby there is shortfall of less than six months in qualifying service for grant of pension. On consideration of the background and nature of appointment of the applicant in the post of

	shortfall of less than six months in qualifying service	
	for grant of pension of the applicant should be	
	condoned by invoking the provisions of Rule 36 of the

	In view of our above observation, we direct the	
	respondent no. 3, Principal Secretary to the
