	promotion in his service career. The grievance of	
	the applicant is that he was not given seniority	
	with effect from the date of his initial appointment	
	in the Project as Clerk-cum-Typist on March 31,	
	1988.	
	Having heard Learned Counsel representing	
	both parties and on consideration of the materials	
	on record, we find that the applicant was initially	
	appointed as Clerk-cum-Typist in the project	
	which was abolished on June 30, 1996. Since the	
	applicant was appointed in the project in terms of	
	the order dated March 30, 1988 issued by the	
	Project Co-ordinator, Danida Pilot Project,	
	Burdwan and since the applicant was
