Ray , Learned Advocate.</i></p> <p><i>The applicants participated in the selection process for recruitment to the post of Constable in Kolkata Police in response to the advertisement published in the Newspaper on January 20, 2012. The contention of the applicants is that they were qualified in physical measurement test and physical efficiency test and appeared in the written examination and also in the interview held in the month of February, 2013. The further contention of the applicants is that they have not been given any appointment in the post of Constable of Police, though one Abhedananda Mondal who was not in the merit list was given appointment in the post of Constable. On consideration of information furnished under the provisions of Right to Information Act, 2005, we find that the last selected candidate from the merit list obtained total 72.25 marks and Abhedananda Mondal obtained 72 marks in the general category. Abhedananda Mondal was in the wait list and he got the appointment when a few candidates in the merit list did not join after receiving appointment. On perusal of result of the present applicants, we find that the applicants have obtained total marks which varied from 58 to 69, which is far below the marks obtained by last selected candidate from the initial merit list and also from the candidate like Abhedananda Mondal whose name appeared in the wait list.

In view of our above findings, we do not find any merit in the present application. As a result, the present application is dismissed.
