	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the	
	respondents to pay interest to the applicant @ 10%	
	per annum on the amount of Gratuity during the	
	period from August 01, 2005 till the date of actual

	The contention of the applicant is that the	
	applicant retired from service on July 31, 2005 but	
	Gratuity and Retirement Benefits of the applicant were	
	not released. Ultimately, the amount of Gratuity was	
	released on October 21, 2013 in pursuance of the	
	direction given by the Hon'ble High Court in W.P.S.T.	
	No. 478/2009. The further contention of the applicant	
	is that a sum of Rs. 3,41,822/- was deducted from the	
	retiring Gratuity of the applicant on the ground of	
	excess payment of salary due to wrong fixation of pay.	
	By order of the Tribunal passed in OA-6062/2008 the	
	said amount of Rs. 3,41,822/- was refunded to the	
	applicant in terms of order dated January 02, 2014	
	issued by the Joint Secretary to the Government of	
	West Bengal, Department of Health & Family Welfare.

Mrs. Agarwal, Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant is entitled to get interest on the amount of Rs. 3,41,822/-, as the said amount was refunded to the applicant only on July 13, 2015, though the Tribunal gave the direction for refund of the said amount on October 06, 2010 in OA-6062/2008. On the other hand, Mr. Roy, Learned Counsel representing the state respondents submits that the applicant is not entitled to get any interest as the amount which was refunded to the applicant was drawn by the applicant in excess of his salary while the applicant was in service.

Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on consideration of the fact that the amount of Rs. 3,41,822/- which was refunded to the applicant was virtually drawn by the applicant in excess of his salary while he was in service, we are of the view that the applicant is not entitled to get any interest on the said amount of money. It is pertinent to point out that the said respondents did not impose any interest at the time of making recovery of the said amount from the retiring Gratuity of the applicant and as such the applicant should not be given any interest while the excess payment has already been refunded Page No. 2
