After passing Madhyamik Examination in applicant passed Diploma 2001 the Medical on Laboratory Technology. During training the applicant studied Applied Mathematics, Applied Chemistry, Applied Physics, which is not equivalent to Higher Secondary. It was clearly mentioned in the advertisement that the examination, interview would be provisional subject to determination of his eligibility and if the candidate at any stage was found ineligible, his candidature would be cancelled. Since during training the subject of studies were not equivalent to Higher Secondary and he did not avail himself of two year diploma course in Laboratory Technologist recognised by the Government of West diploma Bengal or one year course university/Institution recognised by the Government of West Bengal, where basic qualification is Bachelor of Science, we find that the order of termination cannot be
