	Mrs.S.Agarwal, Learned Counsel for the

	of the applicant, but the mother of the applicant retired	
	from service. On consideration of letter dated November	
	27, 2013, we find that the mother of the applicant used to	
	draw monthly salary of Rs. 8,442/- as Government	
	employee and the monthly income of the members of the	
	family of the deceased employee exceeded 90 % of last	
	gross salary of the deceased employee. Since the income	
	of the family of the deceased employee exceeded 90 % of	
	last gross salary of the deceased employee, we are of the	
	view that there was no acute financial crisis in the family
