He further submits that the order of transfer is branded as mala fide as the applicant will not be in a position to pursue the legal remedy for non-implementation of the reasoned order passed by the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Health & Family Welfare in pursuance of the order passed by the Tribunal in OA-613 of 2014 due to the present transfer order.</p> <p>We have heard Mr.G.P.Banerjee, learned counsel representing the State respondents who has opposed the prayer of the applicant.</p> <p>It is relevant to point out that the applicant has not yet moved the Tribunal for non-implementation of reasoned order passed by the Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Health & Family Welfare in pursuance of order dated January 21, 2015 passed by the Tribunal in OA-613 of 2014. BLR/SCN	<p>Principal Secretary to the Government of West Bengal, the Department of Health & Family Welfare, particularly when the legal remedy can be pursued by the applicant sitting in Rampurhat.</p> <p>With regard to the contention of the applicant that the respondents have not complied with the previous order of transfer of the applicant, we find that the applicant challenged the previous order of transfer before the Tribunal and as such the respondents cannot be made liable for non-implementation of the said order of transfer. We do not find any mala fide in the order of transfer of the applicant from Kolkata to Rampurhat particularly when there is no reduction of salary or allowance of the applicant by virtue of the said transfer. The applicant must join his now place of posting within the period of joining time applicable to him under the provisions of West Bengal Service Rules, Part-I.
