In reply Mr. Roy submits that as it is evident from the record that the names of the two applicants were in the recommendation list, appropriate interim order may be passed.

Heard learned advocates for the parties. The matter Let reply be filed by 31st March, 2020. is admitted. Rejoinder, if any, by 9<sup>th</sup> April, 2020. Matter to appear on 23<sup>rd</sup> April, 2020 under the heading "Reply, Rejoinder and Objection".

So far as the prayer for interim order is concerned, in view of the contents in the second paragraph of the letter dated 23<sup>rd</sup> / 24<sup>th</sup> May, 2019, issued by the Secretary to the Commission addressed to the respondent no.2, appearing at page 53 of the Original Application and as the names of the applicants appear in the recommendation list, we are of the view a prima facie case has been made out for passing interim order. Therefore, let there be an interim order directing the respondent no.2 to keep two posts of West Bengal Subordinate Land Revenue Service, Grade-I vacant and be not to be filled up till 22<sup>nd</sup> May, 2020 or until further order, whichever is earlier.
