and the departmental representative of the state respondents, we are of the view that the respondent no. 3 should consider entitlement of the applicants to receive arrears of remuneration in terms of the judgment and order passed by the special Bench of the Tribunal in OA 491 of 2009.

Accordingly, we direct the respondent no. 3, District Land & Land Reforms Officer, Jalpaiguri to consider the representation submitted by the applicants on April 27, 2018 in terms of the judgment and order passed by the special Bench of the Tribunal in OA 491 of 2009 within a period of 12 (twelve) weeks from the date of communication of the order and take necessary follow up action, if any, within a period of 4 (four) weeks thereafter.

With the above direction, the original application stands disposed of.
