	<p>(b) An Order do issue directing the respondent authorities to transmit all the records pertaining to the said selection process for the post of Fire Engine Operator cum Driver in Fire &amp; Emergency Services, Govt. of West Bengal, before this Hon'ble Tribunal so that conscionable justice can be done.”</p> <p>Mr. M.N. Roy, learned advocate for the applicant submits that in 2010 the selection process was conducted by the Central Selection Committee, Fire &amp; Emergency Services Department, Government of West Bengal. The applicant was successful. The name of the applicant appeared in serial no.82. As he was not appointed, aggrieved, the applicant has written a letter dated 16<sup>th</sup> October 2019 to the Director General of Fire &amp; Emergency Services, West Bengal, the respondent no.2 clarifying his address. In such circumstances, appropriate order may be passed directing the authorities to appoint him in the post of Fire Engine Operator cum Driver.</p> <p>Mr. G.P. Banerjee, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the State respondents submits that the selection process for the post of Fire Engine Operator cum Driver was conducted by the Central Selection Committee of the Fire &amp; Emergency Services Department, Government of</p>

SCN.	<p>West Bengal. As the applicant was successful his name appeared against serial no.82. However, as on scrutiny of documents it transpired that the applicant was having two driving licences, both issued on 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2004 with different addresses, one in Hooghly and other in Burdwan and as the signature of the holder and the signature of the licencing authority are absent in the licence having Hooghly address and as the selection process took place in the year 2010 and the Central Selection Committee of the Fire &amp; Emergency Services Department, Government of West Bengal, which had conducted the selection process, was dissolved long back, no order may be passed.</p> <p>Heard Mr. Roy and Mr. Banerjee, the learned advocates for the parties. Since we find that the selection process took place in the year 2010 and the list of the successful candidates was published in the said year and being aggrieved the applicant filed this application after nine years and as the applicant has two driving licences with two different addresses and as we are not satisfied with the contents of the letter dated 16<sup>th</sup> October 2019 addressed to the Director General of Fire &amp; Emergency Services, West Bengal, the respondent no.2, no order is passed on this application.
