	death of his father, the applicant and his mother	
	approached the authority for compassionate	
	appointment. However, his prayer was rejected by	
	the authority on 13.10.2009 (Annexure D) basically	
	on the ground that the brother of the applicant is in	
	government service. Further, they have also	
	received lump sum amount. Therefore, there is no	
	financial crisis. However, subsequently on the basis	
	of application made by the mother of the applicant	
	on the ground that his elder son is residing	
	separately, the authority had again considered the	
	case of the applicant. However, the authority after	
	re-examination of the prayer had rejected the claim	
	of the applicant on the self-same ground vide order	
	dated 19.03.2010. As per the applicant, he again	
	preferred an application before the authority and till	
	date of filing of the application no steps have been	
	taken on that account. Being aggrieved he has filed	
	the instant application.	
	The respondents have filed their written	
	statements wherein it has been stated that in earlier	
	three occasions the case of the applicant was	
	considered but he was not found fit as the mother of	
	the applicant was getting pension out of two	
	brothers including the applicant, the other brother is	
	in government service and the sister is already

	married. Moreover, the applicant's father died in the	
	year 2004. Thus, there is no immediate financial	
	need of the family. Therefore, the counsel for the	
	respondents has prayed for rejection of the OA.	
	We have heard both the parties and perused	
	the records. It is noted that admittedly the brother	
	of the applicant is in government service and the	
	sister is already married. Mother is getting her	
	pension. Further, his prayer was also earlier	
	rejected on 2009 and 2010, which was not	
	challenged by the applicant at that point of time.	
	Therefore, we do not find any merit to entertain the	
	OA. Accordingly, the application is <b>dismissed</b> being	
	hopelessly barred by limitation as well as being	
	devoid of merit.
