	The applicants have prayed for direction upon the respondents	
	for refixation of their pay scale in the promotional post of	
	Additional Supervisory Head Clerk in the establishment of District	
	Magistrate and Collector, Bankura in terms of order of promotion	
	dated December 27, 2013 issued by the District Magistrate,	
	Bankura (annexure C to the original application).	
	Mrs. Mitra, Learned Counsel for the applicants submits on	
	instruction from her clients that the applicant No. 1 is not willing to	
	proceed with the hearing of this case. Accordingly, the original	
	application stands dismissed as not pressed, so far as prayer of the	
	applicant No. 1 is concerned.	
	The other 2 (two) applicants — Sasti Charan Bhakat and Pradip	
	Kumar Rajak got promotion on provisional basis to the post of	
	Additional Supervisory Head Clerk from the post of Upper Division	
	Clerk (UDC) in the establishment of the respondent No. 2 by virtue	
	of order No. 331/2013 dated December 27, 2013 issued by the	
	respondent No. 2. The applicant No. 2 got promotion to the post	
	Additional Supervisory Head Clerk from the post of Upper Division Clerk (UDC) in the establishment of the respondent No. 2 by virtue of order No. 331/2013 dated December 27, 2013 issued by the

of Additional Supervisory Head Clerk on October 1, 2013 and	
retired from service on November 30, 2015 and the applicant No.	
3 got promotion to the post of Additional Supervisory Head Clerk	
on April 1, 2013 and retired from service on January 31, 2016. The	
contention of the applicants is that they have not been granted pay	
scale of the promotional post of Additional Supervisory Head Clerk	
with effect from the date of their promotion. The further	
contention of the applicants is that they discharged their duty as	
Additional Supervisory Head Clerk in the establishment of the	
respondent No. 2 till the date of their superannuation, and as such	
they are entitled to get the financial benefit of the said	
promotional post.	
With the above factual matrix, Mrs. Mitra, Learned Counsel for	
the applicants contends that the applicants have the right to get	
their pay fixed in the pay scale of the promotional post of	
Additional Supervisory Head Clerk in terms of the promotion	
granted to them on December 27, 2013. On the other hand, Mr.	
Bhattacharyya, the authorised representative of the State	
respondents has relied on order No. 5/2014 dated January 24,	
2014 issued by the respondent No. 2 (annexure R-1 to the reply	
filed by the State respondents) and submitted that the provisional	
order of promotion granted to the applicants, subject to the	
approval of the Finance Department, was cancelled in terms of	
Memorandums issued by the Finance Department and Department	
of Land and Land Reforms, Government of West Bengal. He	
further submits that the order of cancellation of promotion was	
duly communicated to all the applicants including applicant No. 1	
	of Additional Supervisory Head Clerk on October 1, 2013 and retired from service on November 30, 2015 and the applicant No. 3 got promotion to the post of Additional Supervisory Head Clerk on April 1, 2013 and retired from service on January 31, 2016. The contention of the applicants is that they have not been granted pay scale of the promotional post of Additional Supervisory Head Clerk with effect from the date of their promotion. The further contention of the applicants is that they discharged their duty as Additional Supervisory Head Clerk in the establishment of the respondent No. 2 till the date of their superannuation, and as such they are entitled to get the financial benefit of the said promotional post. With the above factual matrix, Mrs. Mitra, Learned Counsel for the applicants contends that the applicants have the right to get their pay fixed in the pay scale of the promotional post of Additional Supervisory Head Clerk in terms of the promotion granted to them on December 27, 2013. On the other hand, Mr. Bhattacharyya, the authorised representative of the State respondents has relied on order No. 5/2014 dated January 24, 2014 issued by the respondent No. 2 (annexure R-1 to the reply filed by the State respondents) and submitted that the provisional order of promotion granted to the applicants, subject to the approval of the Finance Department, was cancelled in terms of Memorandums issued by the Finance Department and Department of Land and Land Reforms, Government of West Bengal. He further submits that the order of cancellation of promotion was

	who had put his signature at the time of receiving copy of the	
	order of cancellation of promotion on January 28, 2014. Mr.	
	Bhattacharyya further argues that the applicants were well aware	
	of the fact of cancellation of promotion as they received salary in	
	the pay scale attached to the post of UDC till the date of their	
	retirement from service.	
	Having heard Learned Counsel for the applicants and the	
	authorised representative of the State respondents and on	
	consideration of the materials on record, we find that the	
	respondent No. 2 granted promotion to the applicants in the post	
	of Additional Supervisory Head Clerk on purely provisional basis,	
	subject to approval of the Finance Department, Government of	
	West Bengal. Subsequently, the respondent No. 2 had to consider	
	the Memorandums issued by the Finance Department,	
	Government of West Bengal and Memorandums issued by the	
	Department of Land and Land Reforms, Government of West	
	Bengal for cancellation of provisional promotion granted to the	
	applicants. Since the initial order of promotion was granted on	
	purely provisional basis, subject to approval of the Finance	
	Department, Government of West Bengal, the subsequent order of	
	cancellation of promotion of the applicants by the respondent No.	
	2 in terms of Memorandums issued by the Finance Department	
	and Land and Land Reforms Department on January 24, 2014 is	
	justified under the law. We do not find any illegality or	
	arbitrariness in issuing the order of cancellation of promotion of	
	the applicants, as the previous order of promotion was purely on	
	provisional basis and subject to approval of the Finance

	applicants received the salary in the pay scale attached to the post	
	of UDC in the establishment of the respondent No. 2 unerringly	
	points out that the applicants never received the pay scale of the	
	post of promotion to Additional Supervisory Head Clerk. Since the	
	applicants retired in the pay scale attached to the post of UDC, we	
	can safely infer that the applicants had full knowledge about the	
	order of cancellation of their promotion to the post of Additional	
	Supervisory Head Clerk in the establishment of the respondent No.	
	2.	
	In view of our above observation, we cannot persuade ourselves	
	to hold that the applicants No. 2 and 3 are entitled to get pay scale	
	of Additional Supervisory Head Clerk in the establishment of	
	respondent No. 2.	
	As a result, the original application stands disposed of.
