It appears from the application that late Sachipati Ghatak worked as an Ambulance Driver at Katwa Sub-Divisional Hospital, Burdwan during May, 1965, as per memo dated 16<sup>th</sup> August, 1983 appearing at page- 19A of the application. It appears that no other records are available in the office at Katwa. After falling ill, Sachipati Ghatak, while in service, had expired on 28<sup>th</sup> December, 1981. From the statements made and the grounds contained in the application we find that the application mainly proceeds with regard to issue of appointment on compassionate ground.
