Banerjee Learned Advocate</p> <p>The applicant has filed this original application under Section 19 of the West Bengal Administrative Tribunal's Act, 1985 praying for direction upon the respondents to issue appointment letter in favour of the applicant for the post of Constable on the basis of the selection held on January 22, 2017 and May 22, 2017, if the applicant is found to have secured marks higher than the marks obtained by the last selected candidate.</p> <p>The contention of the applicant is that the applicant participated in the selection process for recruitment to the post of Constable (Male) in West Bengal Police. The further contention of the applicant is that the applicant was found suitable in physical measurement test and physical efficiency test and was permitted to appear in the written examination. It is also contended on behalf of the applicant that the applicant was called for the interview on the basis of marks obtained in the written examination, but the appointment letter has not been issued in favour of the</p>

The grievance of the applicant is that the aggregate of marks of both written test and interview of the last selected candidate was not supplied to the applicant even after submission of application under the provisions of the Right to Information Act.</p> <p>The status report submitted on behalf of the State respondents by the Chairman of West Bengal Police Recruitment Board indicates that the last selected candidate in General Category obtained total 54.33 marks, which is the aggregate of marks obtained in the written examination and the marks obtained in the interview. The present applicant obtained total 51.785 marks which is the aggregate of written test (44.625 marks) and interview (7.16 marks). Since the applicant obtained less marks in aggregate than the last selected candidate, who was appointed in the General Category in the post of Constable (Male) in West Bengal Police, we do not find any merit in the present application.
