	candidate in General Category obtained total 54.33 marks,	
	which is the aggregate of marks obtained in the written	
	examination and the marks obtained in the interview. The	
	present applicant obtained total 51.785 marks which is the	
	aggregate of written test (44.625 marks) and interview	
	(7.16 marks). Since the applicant obtained less marks in	
	aggregate than the last selected candidate, who was	
	appointed in the General Category in the post of Constable	
	(Male) in West Bengal Police, we do not find any merit in	
	the present application. As a result, the present	
	application is dismissed.
