	24-Parganas Division and was simultaneously	
	to perform stand-by duty at the Administrative

	duty under the Divisional Fire Officer on 16-03-	
	2016 (afternoon) and subsequently released on	
	17-03-2016 from the office of the Divisional	
	Fire Officer and again joined in the same	
	capacity to the Department of Fire and	
	Emergency Services on stand-by offices on 18-	
	03-2016 (afternoon). However, as per the	
	applicant, due to his personal difficulties, he

	2017, enclosing a Medical Certificate of his	
	father's illness with it, which can not be a	
	ground for his unauthorized absence during	
	the period of probation. His prayer dated 01-	
	02-2018, 27-02-2018, 07-03-2018, 09-03-	
	2018, 13-03-2018, 16-03-2018, seeking to	
	join his service are also regretted due to	
	unsatisfactory performance throughout the	
	period of probation.	
	Shri Siddhartha Bose, in his total	
	probation period, attended his duty only for	
	a short period, i.e., from 16-03-	
	2016(afternoon) to 18-03-2016 for just	
	3(three) days. He did not appear in the	
	Departmental Examination which is	
	mandatory to clear the same within the	
	period of probation. Further, he did not even	
	submit any request to appear in the same,	
	thus violating Rule 5 & Rule 6 of	
	Notification No. 1832-F(P); dated 01-03-	
	2013, of Finance Department, Government	
	of West Bengal.

	violating Rule 3(6) of West Bengal Services	
	(Duties, Rights and Obligations of the	
	Government employees) Rules 1980.	
	Since, he was under the period of	
	probation and his conduct has been found	
	highly unsatisfactory, no formal	
	departmental proceedings was launched	
	against him.	
	Keeping in views all the facts and	
	circumstances mentioned above, and after	
	application of my judicious mind I strongly	
	feel that Shri Siddhartha Bose is not fit for	
	the Government job. Hence Shri Sidharthan	
	Bose is hereby discharged from his service

	However as per the applicant, he has not been	
	granted any opportunity of being heard before	
	discharge from duty. Being aggrieved with, he	
	has filed the instant application though	
	affidavit of service has been filed but none	
	appear for the respondents.	
	We have heard the applicant and	
	perused the records specially the impugned	
	order wherefrom it is noted that the applicant	
	was discharged from the duty as he had only	
	perform his duty for 3(three) days i.e. on 16-03-	
	2016 to 18-03-2016. When he was asked to	
	show cause vide letter dated 28-04-2016 that	
	time also he was absent and replied after a	
	prolonged period of more than one year on 19-	
	12-2017 only enclosing some medical certificate	
	of his father. It is admitted fact that during his	
	absent period, he never intimated the authority.	
	From the perusal of the appointment letter	
	dated 08-01-2016, it is clear that continuation	
	of his service by way of absorbing as regular

	passing the examination. Further from the	
	perusal of the impugned order, it is observed	
	that the applicant was granted opportunity by	
	issuing show cause on 28-04-2016 even then	
	he replied the same on 19-12-2017 i.e. after	
	more than one and a half years. It is also	
	admitted fact that he never intimated the	
	authority about his absence. Therefore we do	
	not find that there is any violation of natural	
	justice as he has been granted opportunity to	
	resume his duty and also to reply reasons for	
	unauthorised absent. It is also settle principal	
	of law that probationer has no right to continue	
	in service unless and until he perform his duty	
	satisfactory. Thus we do not find any reason to	
	entertain the application. Accordingly, the OA is	
	dismissed being devoid of any merit.
