	Finance Department, Audit Branch read with letter no. 2196-F	
	(Pen) dated December 9, 1991 issued by the Deputy Secretary,	
	Finance Department, Audit Branch, Government of West Bengal,	
	the applicant is entitled to get interest on delayed payment of	
	gratuity for the period beyond 3 months when the gratuity	
	becomes due till the end of the preceeding month on which	
	payment was actually made, if there was no lapse on the part of	
	the applicant. On consideration of rate of interest payable on the	
	amount deposited in Public Provident Fund or General Provident	
	Fund and rate of interest paid on long term fixed deposit by the	
	nationalised bank, we are of the view that interest should be paid
