Majumdar, Learned Advocates.</p> <p>For the Respondent : None.</p> <p>Liberty is given to the applicant to implead the Sub-Divisional Officer, Katwa, Purba Burdwan as respondent No. 6 by way of amendment of cause title of the original application in course of this day.</p> <p>The contention of the applicant is that he was paid the amount of GPF, pension and other retirement benefits by the Executive Engineer, Damodar Canal Division in terms of the order passed by the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court in WPCRC No. 246(W) of 2015 and WPST No. 447 of 2010. The further contention of the applicant is that on November 21, 2017, he has received an intimation from the Additional Treasury Officer, Katwa Treasury about excess payment of Rs.1,47,313/- due to incorrect calculation of interest on arrears of pension in terms of the order passed by the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court. The grievance of the applicant is that he is totally in the dark about the calculation made by the concerned authority for recovery of Rs.1,47,313/- as excess payment, which is being deducted from the pension of the applicant every month by instalments.</p>

Since the calculation sheet for coming to the conclusion of excess payment of Rs.1,47,313/- has not been disclosed to the applicant by the Additional Treasury Officer, Katwa Treasury, we would like to direct the respondent No. 6, Sub-Divisional Officer, Katwa to furnish the calculation sheet for arriving at the conclusion of excess payment of Rs.1,47,313/- to the applicant, which is being deducted from his pension by instalments, within a period of four weeks from the date of receiving copy of this order. The calculation sheet must be supplied to the applicant in addition to forwarding the same to Ld. Registrar of the Tribunal within a period of six weeks from this date.

The applicant is directed to communicate the copy of the order along with one notice and copy of the original application along with all annexures on the added respondent No. 6 by speed post within a period of one week from this date and file affidavit of service in this regard on the next date of hearing.
