Lahiri, learned advocate for the applicant submits that though the applicants have crossed the upper age limit, however, as the applicants are working in the same Department as Data Entry Operators, in view of the judgements of the Tribunal passed in OA-281 of 2014 (Ashim Nayak & 13 Ors. vs. The State of West Bengal & Ors.) and in OA-392 of 2018 (Satyendra Nath Karmakar & Ors. vs. The State of West Bengal & Ors.), the respondents may be directed to allow the applicants to participate in the selection process condoning their age.</p> <p>Mr. S. Ghosh, learned advocate for the respondents submits that as the posts are different as mentioned in the judgements and as the applicants do not fulfil the upper age limit, they are not entitled to the order as prayed for. Moreover, the representation filed is before the Director of Health Services and not before the concerned authority.</p>
