	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the	
	respondents for grant of provisional pension w.e.f. August 1,	
	2014 in terms of the provisions of Rule 10(2) of West Bengal	
	Services (Death-cum-Retirement Benefit) Rules, 1971 (in short,	
	DCRB Rules, 1971).	
	The contention of the applicant is that on December 24, 2013	
	when the applicant was working as Forest Range Officer under	
	the respondent No. 4, Divisional Forest Officer, Nadia,	
	Murshidabad Division, disciplinary proceeding was initiated	
	against the applicant by issuance of charge sheet. The further	
	contention of the applicant is that the disciplinary proceeding is	
	still continuing against the applicant even after attaining the age	
	of superannuation in terms of the provisions of Rule 10 of the	
	DCRB Rules, 1971. Learned Counsel representing the applicant	
	submits that the applicant has received provisional pension upto	
	the month of September, 2018 in an irregular manner in terms of	
	the provisions of Rule 10 (2) of the DCRB Rules, 1971.

Learned Counsel representing the State respondents submits that the provisional pension payable to the applicant after March, 2017 is in the process of revision and the same will be paid to the applicant in due course.

Since the disciplinary proceeding has not yet been concluded, we are of the view that the applicant is entitled to get provisional pension in terms of the provisions of Rule 10 (2) of the DCRB Rules, 1971. Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that the applicant has already received provisional pension upto the month of September, 2018. Accordingly, respondent No. 3, Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forest, Human Resource Development, Government of West Bengal is directed to take necessary steps for grant of provisional pension in favour of the applicant in terms of the provisions of Rule 10 (2) of the DCRB Rules, 1971 from the month of October, 2018 till the conclusion of disciplinary proceeding pending against the applicant within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of the order.

With the above direction, the original application stands disposed of.
