	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents to	
	permit him to join for duty by granting leave and on cancellation of	
	order dated February 7, 2014 passed by the Block Development	
	Officer, Arambagh and order dated November 28, 2014 passed by	
	the District Magistrate, Hooghly.	
	The applicant claims to be a Group D employee in the	
	establishment of the Respondent No. 4, Block Development	
	Officer, Arambagh. The contention of the applicant is that he was	
	absent from duty since December 28, 2012 due to illness of	
	members of family and himself and he was not permitted to	
	resume duty when he was declared medically fit by the doctor. The	
	further contention of the applicant is that the Respondent No. 4	
	passed an order on February 7, 2014 for stoppage of salary of the	
	applicant due to unauthorised absence for prolonged period of	
	time. It is also contended on behalf of the applicant that on	
	November 28, 2014, the Respondent No. 2 communicated to the	
	Respondent No. 4 for taking action against the applicant for	
	unauthorised absence during prolonged period of time in terms of	
	Rule 34 of WBSR Pt. I.

	With the above factual matrix, Learned Counsel for the applicant contends that the applicant is physically fit, but he has not been permitted by the Respondent No. 4 to resume duty, resulting in non-drawal of salary from February 7, 2014. None appears on behalf of the State respondents in spite of service of notice as reflected from the affidavit of service filed on behalf of the applicant. On consideration of the materials on record, we find that the applicant is absent from duty from December 28, 2012 and the said	3
	absence has not been regularised by grant of leave till date and as such the question of payment of salary to the applicant does not arise at this stage. Since no disciplinary action has yet been taken against the applicant and since the applicant has claimed to be medically fit for resuming duty, we are of the view that the applicant should be permitted to resume duty and his prolonged period of absence should be regularised by grant of leave in accordance with law. The applicant is entitled to get salary only after regularisation of absence and grant of leave in favour of the applicant.	
	Accordingly, the Respondent No. 2, District Magistrate, Hooghly is directed to consider for regularisation of absence of the applicant by grant of leave to the credit of the applicant and by grant of Extra Ordinary Leave in accordance with the provisions of WBSR Pt. I and permit the applicant to resume duty by passing a
