	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the	
	respondents to grant him family pension in place of private	
	respondent no. 7 and for consideration of the objection raised by	
	the applicant in connection with family pension enjoyed by the	
	private respondent.	
	The applicant claims to be the son of one Basanta Kumar	
	Roy from his first wife since deceased. The contention of the	
	applicant is that his father Basanta Kumar Roy did not marry the	
	private respondent and thereby the private respondent is not the	
	legally married wife of Basanta Kumar Roy. The further	
	contention of the applicant is that one Ranjana Roy born from	
	the alleged wedlock between the private respondent and	
	Basanta Kumar Roy is not the legal heir of Basanta Kumar Roy	
	since deceased. It appears from the materials on record that	
	Basanta Kumar Roy, Constable of Police retired from service in	
	the year 1994. Learned Counsel for the applicant submits that	
	Basanta Kumar Roy died on February 3, 2015. He further

submits that the first wife of Basanta Kumar Roy namely Radha Rani Roy died on July 18, 2014.

It appears from the reply submitted by the respondent no. 4 that the deceased constable Basanta Kumar Roy nominated the private respondent as nominee for receiving the death gratuity on January 9, 1960. The reply further indicates that the private respondent submitted the certificate of marriage between Basanta Kumar Roy and herself before the respondent no. 4 on January 9, 1985, though the District Magistrate of Coochbehar has issued legal heirship certificate of Basanta Kumar Roy in favour of the present applicant on December 5, 2017. Admittedly, the present applicant has instituted Title Suit no. 30 of 2015 before the Court of Learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Mekhligani praying for declaration that the private respondent is not the legally married wife of Basanta Kumar Roy and that the said private respondent and her daughter Ranjana Roy are not the legal heirs of deceased Basanta Kumar Roy. The said Title Suit is still pending for adjudication before the Learned Civil Judge (Junior Division), Mekhliganj.

With the above factual matrix, Learned Counsel for the applicant submits in response to our query that the applicant was aged about 42 years at the time of death of his father. The adult son of a deceased Government employee is not entitled to get family pension in terms of Rule 7(2) of the West Bengal
