	Mr. Mitra, Departmental Representative, submits	
	that the overdrawn amount deducted is Rs. 3,96,867/- on	
	account of mistake in pay and allowances and not as	
	stated in the petition.	
	Heard Mr. Ghosh, learned advocate for the	
	applicant and Mr. Mitra, Departmental Representative	
	for the Principal Accountant General (A&E), West	
	Bengal. Perused the application, particularly the	
	annexures at pages 39 and 42 thereof. We find that the	
	total overdrawn amount regarding pay and allowances	
	is Rs. 3,96,867/- which is not permissible in view of the	
	judgment of Supreme Court in State of Punjab and	
	Others etcVs- Rafiq Masih (supra). Hence, the said	
	deduction of Rs. 3,96,867/- is set aside and quashed. The	
	application is allowed. Accordingly, the Block	
	Development Officer, Khargram, Murshidabad - the	
	respondent no2 is directed to refund the said sum of Rs.	
	3,96,867/- to the applicant within twelve weeks from the	
	date of presentation of a copy of the order.
