	In OA 159 of 2016, the applicant has prayed for direction upon	
	the respondents for fixation of pay and disbursement of salary for	
	the period from September 30, 2008 to February 20, 2009 and	
	consequential yearly increment and other ancillary benefits	
	including relaxation in payment of Professional Tax as physically	
	challenged person. In OA 160 of 2016, the applicant has prayed	
	for direction upon the respondents to grant financial benefits to	
	the applicant for completion of 8 years of service, 16 years of	
	service and 25 years of service under Career Advancement Scheme	
	(CAS).	
	It appears from the materials on record that a criminal case was	
	started against the applicant being Kotwali PS Case No. 325 of 2008	
	dated June 16, 2008 under Section 498A/302 of the Indian Penal	
	Code when the applicant was working as Medical Technologist	
	(Lab) at JD Hospital in Cooch Behar. The applicant was detained in

	applicant was released on bail on September 30, 2008, but the	
	criminal case is still pending for hearing before the appropriate	
	Court of Law. The applicant was allowed to resume duty by the	
	order of the Director of Health Services, West Bengal on February	
	20, 2009. The applicant was transferred from Coochbehar to	
	Nadia. The applicant has been denied yearly increment by the	
	Superintendent of District Hospital, Nadia by order dated February	
	15, 2015. The further grievance of the applicant is that he has not	
	been given financial benefit for completion of 8 years of service, 16	
	years of service and 25 years of service on the basis of CAS.	
	Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on	
	consideration of the background of suspension of the applicant and	
	pendency of the criminal case against him till date, we are of the	
	view that the entitlement of the applicant to get his pay refixed	
	and to get benefit of CAS cannot be decided till the final decision of	
	the criminal case. If the applicant is acquitted of the charge by the	
	Criminal Court, it is the duty of the applicant to produce certified	
	copy of the judgment delivered by the Criminal Court before the	
	Respondent No. 3, Chief Medical Officer of Health, Nadia and pray	
	for payment of salary of the applicant in terms of Rule 72 of WBSR	
	Pt. I and other consequential financial benefits like refixation of	
	pay, giving annual increment and CAS benefit. The Respondent No.	
	3 will consider the judgment passed by the Criminal Court, if	
	produced before him and take follow-up action for giving all
