	learned advocate submits that since the applicant fulfils	
	the essential qualifications, particularly (A) (ii) of the	
	advertisement, which is evident from pages 23 and 24 of	
	the application, appropriate order may be passed.	
	Mr. G.P. Banerjee, learned advocate appearing	
	on behalf of the respondents, submits that on a closer	
	scrutiny of the annexures at page 23 and 24 of the original	
	application it is evident that the applicant does not fulfil	
	minimum total five years experience from a recognised	
	institution in manufacturing or testing of drugs.

In order to answer the issue it is appropriate to refer to essential qualification (A) (ii) which is set out hereunder: "A. Essential:(ii) Experience of work in recognized institutions in the manufacture or testing of drugs or enforcement of the provisions of the Drugs and Cosmetics Act, 1940 (23 of 1940) for a minimum total period of five years." It is evident from the experience certificate issued by the Fresenius Kabi Oncology Limited appearing at page 23 of the application, that the applicant had worked from 4th October, 2010 till 30th March, 2013. However, the certificate issued by TCG Lifesciences Private Limited, appearing at page 24 of the application, regarding experience of work, does not mention the length of service. Therefore, it cannot be said that the applicant **SCN** has fulfilled five years experience of work in recognised institution in manufacturing or testing of drugs.
