	were made, however, no order has been passed.	
	Referring to the intimation dated 11th May, 2001 issued	
	by the Deputy Secretary, School Education	
	Department, being annexure P-5 of this application, it	
	is submitted though benefit of past service has not	
	been granted as according to the respondents there is	
	no authentic document showing that the applicant had	
	joined government service through proper channel, in	
	view of the memo no. $\frac{180-\text{Edn.(B)}}{\text{IM}-83/88}$ dated 20th May,	
	1988 issued by the Secretary, Education Department	
	(Budget Branch), Government of West Bengal,	
	appropriate order may be passed.
