	Admittedly the applicants had applied for M.Sc.	
	Nursing course. They were selected and deposited the	
	fees with the West Bengal University of Health	
	Sciences and continued with their studies, which	
	according to the applicants, was within the knowledge	
	of the respondents. According to the applicants since it	
	is the convention for long that formal release order is	
	not required, the memo dated 4th August, 2020 is	
	unjust and illegal. Further as it is an act of	
	discrimination and nepotism at least 5 candidates	
	similarly situated are pursuing M. Sc (Nursing) course.	
	It appears from the application that	
	overwhelming number of students are continuing	
	M.Sc. Nursing course after getting formal release order	
	which has not been obtained by the applicants. Merely	
	because some candidates are continuing their studies	
	in an unauthorised manner, as evident from paragraph	
	4 of the supplementary application, cannot confer a	
	right on applicants to further their case. A wrong, if	
	any, done by others cannot confer right on the	
	applicants. Hence, no order can be passed on this
