	allowed to participate in the selection process for	
	recruitment to the post of Medical Technologist Grade-III	
	of different categories in response to the advertisement	
	dated May 28, 2018 issued by the Respondent No.3 by	
	way of relaxation of age bar.	
	Two (2) applicants of two (2) original applications	
	have been working as Medical Technologists on	
	contractual basis in different Institutes. All these	
	applicants are willing to participate in the selection	
	process for recruitment to the post of Medical	
	Technologists Grade-III of different categories in the	
	scale of pay of Rs. 7,100/ Rs. 37,600/- (Pay Band -3	
	with Grade Pay Rs. 3,600) and other allowances	
	admissible as per existing rules in response to the	
	advertisement dated May 28, 2018 issued by the	
	Respondent No.3. The common contention of both the	
	applicants is that they have crossed the maximum age	
	limit as mentioned in the advertisement for the purpose	
	of participation in the selection process. However, the	

other common contention made on behalf of the

applicants is that both of them have other essential

qualifications for recruitment to the post of Medical

	applicants are willing to participate in the selection		
	process by submitting the application within the		
	prescribed time limit as mentioned in the advertisement,		
	but they apprehend that their applications will be		
	rejected for crossing the maximum age limit prescribed		
	in the advertisement.		
	Now, the question for consideration of the		
	Tribunal is whether the applicants can be granted		
	permission to participate in the selection process by the		
	relaxation of age bar mentioned in the advertisement.		
	Mr. Banerjee, Learned Counsel appearing for the		
	applicants has referred to order dated March 7, 2014		
	passed by this Tribunal in OA- 281 of 2014 (Ashim		
	Nayak & 13 Ors. V. State of West Bengal & Ors.), order		
	dated March 10, 2016 passed by the Hon'ble High Court		
	in WPST No.125 of 2014 with CAN No. 2159 of 2016		
	(Dipak Saha & Others V. State of West Bengal & Ors.)		
	and the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in		
	"Keshav Narayan Gupta & Ors. V. Jila Parishad,		
	Shivpuri (MP) & Anr." reported in (1998) 9 SCC 78 and		
	submitted that the Tribunal can grant permission to the

	applicants to participate in the selection process by	
	relaxation of the age bar, if the applicants are otherwise	
	eligible to apply for the post of Medical Technologists	
	Grade-III of different categories as mentioned in the	
	advertisement. Mr. S. Ghosh, Learned Counsel	
	representing the State Respondents contends that the	
	applicants should submit the application both online and	
	by filing one hard copy of the application before the	
	Respondent No.3 within the prescribed time limit	
	mentioned in the advertisement. He further submits that	
	relaxation of age should have some limitation and the	
	said limitation may be fixed by the Tribunal.	
	On consideration of order dated March 7, 2014	
	passed by the Tribunal in "Ashim Nayak & 13 Ors. V.	
	State of West Bengal & Ors." (Supra), we find that in the	
	said case this Tribunal gave direction to the respondents	
	to allow the applicants to participate in the selection	
	process for recruitment to the post of Medical	
	Technologist Grade –III of different categories by way of	
	relaxation of age, subject to fulfilment of other eligibility	
	criteria. Similarly, in the case of "Dipak Saha & Others V.	
	State of West Bengal & Ors" (Supra), the Hon'ble High	
	Court also gave direction to the concerned respondents

	process by relaxation of upper age limit, subject to	
	fulfilment of other eligibility criteria for selection to the	
	post. In "Keshav Narayan Gupta & Ors. V. Jila Parishad,	
	Shivpuri (MP) & Anr." (Supra) the Hon'ble Supreme	
	Court dealt with the case of one person who was	
	working temporarily as Lower Division Clerk for a	
	period of almost twelve (12) years with short period of	
	break. There was some irregularity in the said	
	appointment on temporary basis. The Hon'ble Supreme	
	Court gave direction that when regular appointment to	
	the post of Lower Division Clerk will be made, the case	
	of the concerned applicant must be considered along	
	with other fresh applicants by waiving the age bar in	
	case of the concerned applicant, if necessary. By	
	following the decision of the above cases, we are of the	
	view that the applicants who have been working in the	
	posts of Medical Technologists of different categories on	
	contractual basis for prolonged period of time should not	
	be deprived of the opportunity to participate in the fresh	
	selection process for crossing maximum age limit	
	mentioned in the advertisement. If the applicants are	
	willing to participate in the fresh selection process for	
	recruitment to the post of Medical Technologist Grade-III

	the selection process by relaxation of maximum age limit		
	as per advertisement, as the applicants have already		
	been working in the posts of Medical Technologist on		
	contractual basis under the same department.		
	Accordingly, we direct the Respondent No.3,		
	Secretary and Controller of Examination, West Bengal		
	Health Recruitment Board to allow both the applicants of		
	two (2) original applications to participate in the		
	selection process by relaxation of age bar as mentioned		
	in the advertisement dated May 28, 2018, subject to		
	fulfilment of other eligibility criteria. The applicants are		
	at liberty to fill up the form online within the prescribed		
	time limit mentioned in the advertisement dated May 28,		
	2018. The applicants are also directed to submit hard		
	copy of the application before the Respondent No. 3		
	within the prescribed time limit given in the		
	advertisement, so that the Respondent No.3 may take		
	precautionary measures of not rejecting the applications		
	of these two (2) applicants on the ground of age bar. The		
	Respondent No. 3 is directed to ensure acceptance of		
	hard copy of the applications from two (2) applicants
