Mr. Sanyal submits that since the entire selection process lacks transparency, the recruitments be stayed. Since the name of the members of the Recruitment Board for interview was published prior to the date of interview, as the breakup of marks in the final written examination has not been disclosed and as prior to marks interview the secured in the written examination were not disclosed and no final merit list has been published and as there has been violation of reservation policy, the entire selection process and recruitment be stayed. Mr. G. P. Banerjee, learned advocate appearing on behalf of the State respondents submits that the application is misconceived as assuming the names of the members of the Recruitment Board were disclosed prior to interview yet the applicants had participated
