Mitra, Departmental Representative.</p> <p>The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents for refixation of pay of the applicant and disburse arrears of salary and revised pension and other pensionary benefits.</p> <p>The applicant was appointed as Typist and posted in the office of Additional Superintendent of Police, DIB, 24 Parganas on February 10, 1971. Ultimately, she retired on October 31, 2007 from the post of Stenographer. The applicant submitted one representation before the respondent no. 2 on April 27, 2007 immediately before her retirement for fixation of her pay as Schedule B Stenographer. The grievance of the applicant is that she has not been given the scale of pay to which she was entitled for her appointment as Schedule B Stenographer before the date of her retirement from service.</p> <p>Having heard Learned Counsel representing all the parties and on consideration of letter issued by the Superintendent of Police, Baruipur Police District under Memo No. 2064/E dated July 20, 2018, we find that the Superintendent of Police, Baruipur Police District has already revised pay of the applicant and issued letter to the Accountant General (A &amp; E), West Bengal for release of revised pension and revised retiring gratuity in favour of the applicant. The said letter dated July 20, 2018 produced on behalf of the State respondents is kept on record.</p>	

**ORDER SHEET**

Under the above circumstances, the respondent, Principal Accountant General (A & E), West Bengal is directed to take necessary action in terms of Memo No. 2064/E dated July 20, 2018 issued by the Superintendent of Police, Baruipur Police District within a period of 8 weeks from the date of communication of the order.
