	1995 when he was minor but he approach the

	was minor. On attaining the age of	
	adulthood he has come up with a prayer to	
	provide employment on compassionate	
	ground after a lapse of more than 15 years.	
	Most importantly wife of the deceased is a	
	govt. service holder.	
	Employment on compassionate	
	ground is provided to meet up immediate
