	The instant application has been filed mainly		
	challenging the notification dated 9 <sup>th</sup> April, 2018.		
	According to the applicant, erstwhile Staff Selection		
	Commission had issued one advertisement No.		
	04/WBSCC/2016 (Annexure 4) inviting for application to		
	the post of Krishi Prayayukti Sahayak. In the same		
	notification, method of selection has been stipulated as		
	written examination of 150 marks (Part - I - 120 marks		
	and Part – II - 30 marks). It is further stipulated in the		
	said notification, which is as follows:		
	"Scheme of Recruitment:-		
	(i) Candidates shall have to appear at a		
	Written Examination of 150 marks		
	(Part – I: 120 Marks and Part – II:		
	<b>30 marks)</b> , Duration of the written		
	examination will be <b>90 minutes</b> .		
	(ii) Part - I will consist of Multiple		
	Choice Objective Type Questions.		
	There will be 120 questions,

	carrying 1 mark each. There will	
	be negative marking of 0.25 mark	
	for each wrong answer.	
	(iii) Part - II will consist of a single	
	descriptive type question (writing	
	of Precis from a given English	
	passage).	
	NOTE I: Candidates have to mark answers	
	in respect of Multiple Choice Objective Type	
	Questions of Part - I in one side of OMR	
	Answer Script, whereas they shall have to	
	write the descriptive question pertaining to	
	Part - II on the reverse side of the OMR in	
	the space allocated for that purpose.	
	(iv) Answer scripts of Part - II will be	
	evaluated only for those	
	candidates, who will be	
	shortlisted, Category - wise, by	
	the Commission on the basis of	
	marks obtained by them in Part -	
	I.	
	(v) Final merit list for written	
	examination will be prepared by	
	aggregating marks of Part - I and

	NOTE II: Candidates must secure	
	qualifying marks fixed by the	
	Commission in the Part - I and Part -	
	II.	
	NOTE III: Qualifying marks fixed for	
	Part - II will be as the following:-	
	→For Unreserved Candidates /BC A / BC B	
	Category: <b>10 Marks</b>	
	→For Candidates belonging to SC Category	
	: 7 Marks	
	→For Candidates belonging to ST Category:	
	5 Marks"	
	According to the applicant, he applied for the said	
	post and was qualified in the Part - I examination and also	
	appeared in the Part- II. However, he has not been called	
	for interview, in the mean time, Staff Selection Commission	
	was repealed and the selection process was entrusted to	
	Public Service Commission, West Bengal.	
	On 09.04.2018, the Public Service Commission has	
	issued a notification, which is as follows:-	
	"The Commission may fix qualifying cut-off	

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	marks for all the categories of vacancies in each	
	level of the examination i.e. Part – II,	
	Interview, Aggregate."(Annexure A/3)	
	According to the applicant, this notification has created an apprehension to the applicant since in the earlier notification, it was clearly stipulated 10 marks for BC A candidates in Part – II examination. Moreover, he has not been called for interview therefore he is of the apprehension that Public Service Commission has increased the qualifying/cut-off marks and therefore he has been deprived of the selection. Being aggrieved with, he has filed the	
	instant application.  We have heard both the parties and perused the records.	
	The counsel for the respondent No. 2 submits that Public Service Commission has not changed the qualifying marks in Part – II. As per instruction, the counsel for the respondent No. 2 has submitted that the petitioner has not secured the qualifying marks in Part – II. Therefore, he was not being called for interview.	

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	In view of the above, the counsel for the Public Service	3
	Commission is directed to produce the cut-off marks	
	stipulated by the Public Service Commission for Part – II	
	examination as well as the marks obtained by the applicant	
	in Part II by the next date in sealed cover.	
	The counsel for the applicant has prayed for leave to	
	make necessary correction in the Cause Title. Leave is	
	granted.
