The copy of the Judgment is kept with the record.</p> <p>Mr. Srimani, Learned Counsel for the applicant has prayed for stay of operation of the Judgment and order for a period of six (06) weeks to facilitate filing of the Writ Application against the Judgment and order of the Tribunal before the Hon'ble High Court. He submits that the applicant enjoyed interim order to the effect that promotion to the post of Joint Director and subsequent promotion to the post of Additional Director will abide by the decision of the Writ Application. Mr. S.N. Ray, Learned Counsel for the state respondents has opposed the prayer for staying operation of the Judgment and order passed by the Tribunal.</p> <p>Since, we do not find any merit in the original application and since the interim order passed by the Tribunal have seized to operate on the date of delivery of the Judgment, we do not find any merit in the submission made on behalf of the applicant.
