1, 1989. Long after almost ten years of retirement of the applicant, the order was issued by the Assistant Director of Health Services (Administration) on July 20, 2000 to the effect that the Technical Assistants who got promotion from Grade III to Grade II are redesignated as Health Inspector and thereby the benefit of CAS under ROPA Rules, 1990 granted to the said employees for completion of 10 / 20 years of service is deemed to have been cancelled and their cases will be re-examined for granting them benefit of CAS for completion of satisfactory service of 20 years. This order was issued on July 20, 2000 and the father of the applicant died on March 29, 2010 without pursuing the remedy during his life time. After lapse of almost nine years of death of the father of the applicant, the applicant has prayed for the said benefit of service of her father in terms of order dated July 20, 2000 (annexure P-2 to the original application). Even assuming for argument's sake that the benefit, if any, accrued to the father of the applicant in terms of the order dated July 20, 2000 is a continuing cause of action, the said cause of action has come to an end on the date of death of the father of the applicant on March 29, 2010. No explanation is forthcoming as to why the present applicant waited for almost nine years after the death of her father for approaching the Tribunal for getting the benefit of her father which might have accrued in terms of order dated July 20, 2000.

Accordingly, we are of the view that the present application is clearly barred under Section 21 of the Administrative Tribunals Act, 1985. The applicant is, thus, not entitled to get any relief in the
