	The applicant is holding the post of Station Officer at Suri under Birbhum Fire Division. A Charge memo was served on the applicant on May 29, 2014 for conducting departmental enquiry against the applicant. The said departmental enquiry was concluded by the Enquiry Officer and the report was submitted before the Disciplinary Authority. The respondent no.2 being the Disciplinary Authority of the applicant issued second show cause notice on May 2, 2016 and reply to the same was given by the applicant on May 9, 2016, but no final order has yet been passed	
	by the said respondent no. 2. The respondent no. 2 also issued another second show cause notice on December 19, 2016 and reply to the same was given by the applicant on January 2, 2017,

	Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on	
	consideration of the fact that the disciplinary proceeding pending	
	against the applicant has not been concluded within a period of	
	three years from the date of service of charge memo on the	
	applicant and the fact that the applicant is not responsible for the	
	delay in conclusion of the disciplinary proceeding, we are of the	
	view that the case of the applicant should be considered for	
	provisional promotion by the respondent no. 2 in terms of	
	Memorandum dated June 12, 1980 issued by the Department of	
	Home, Personnel and Administrative Reforms, Government of	
	West Bengal. Since the disciplinary proceeding is still pending
