	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents	
	to pay him full salary from June 24, 1997 to September 30, 2009	
	and other ancillary reliefs.	
	The applicant claims to have been working as Upper Division	
	Assistant in the office of West Bengal Commercial Tax. The	
	contention of the applicant is that he was suspended from service	
	w.e.f. June 24, 1997 and departmental enquiry was started against	
	him by issuance of the charge sheet on July 14, 1997. The further	
	contention of the applicant is that a criminal case was also started	
	against him on the self-same charge on which departmental	
	enquiry was initiated, but the applicant was acquitted of the	
	charge by the competent Court of Law on July 7, 2001. It is also	
	contended on behalf of the applicant that the applicant	
	approached this Tribunal for revocation of suspension and	
	completion of departmental enquiry within specific period of time.	
	By order dated December 2, 2013 passed in OA 540 of 2013, this	
	Tribunal quashed the disciplinary proceeding pending against the	
	applicant. Learned Counsel for the applicant further submits that

	the State respondents challenged the order of the Tribunal before	
	the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court and ultimately on	
	February 24, 2016 the Division Bench of the Hon'ble High Court	
	extended the period for completion of departmental enquiry upto	
	April 30, 2016 by order dated February 24, 2016 in CAN No. 2243	
	of 2015 arising out of WPST No. 200 of 2014. It appears from the	
	said order that if the departmental enquiry is not completed by	
	April 30, 2016, the proceedings will be dropped without further	
	reference to the Hon'ble High Court. It is specific submission of	
	Learned Counsel for the applicant that the departmental enquiry	
	was not concluded within April 30, 2016 and by virtue of the order	
	of the Hon'ble High Court the said departmental enquiry was	
	dropped.	
	Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on	
	consideration of the materials on record, we cannot come to the	
	conclusion that the applicant has been acquitted of the charge by	
	the Criminal Court in the year 2001. However, since the applicant	
	has already retired from service on September 30, 2009 and the	
	departmental enquiry if not concluded within April 30, 2016 must	
	have been dropped, we are of the view that the entitlement of the	
	applicant to get financial benefit before retirement and pensionary	
	benefit after retirement need to be decided by the authority	
	concerned. It is specifically contended by the applicant that a	
	representation in this regard is submitted by the applicant before	
	the Respondent No. 2 and other respondents on May 2, 2018, but	
	the same is still pending for consideration. Accordingly,
