	Therefore, they are not covered by the Finance Department	
	Notification dated 25.05.2013 and 16.09.2011. Further	
	they are not even be considered as a casual labour and was	
	<i>in Govt. employment thus no question of regularisation has</i>	
	arisen. The counsel for the respondents has prayed for	
	dismissal of the O.A.	
	We have heard the parties and perused the records. It	
	is noted that in their representation dated 16.06.2016	
	(Annexure G), the applicants themselves has admitted that	
	they worked in M. N. R. E. G. A. Scheme as a self-help	
	group. Further from the Notification dated 29.07.2015	
	also, it is noted that the applications are called for forming	
	of self-help group under M. N. R. E. G. A. Scheme.	
	Therefore, in our considered view, there is no scope for	
	considering their case for regularisation or to extend any	
	benefit of Finance Department Notification. Thus, we do	
	not find any reason to entertain the instant O.A.	
	Accordingly, we dismiss the O.A. with no order as to cost.
