	It is noted that the instant application has been filed					
	challenging the impugned order dated 12.02.2014					
	(Annexure G) whereby the prayer of the applicant for					
	compassionate appointment was rejected on the ground that					
	the applicant had applied in the prescribed pro-forma on					
	24.01.2012 i.e. after a lapse of two years from death of his					
	mother. As per the applicant, his mother died on					
	31.10.2009. Thereafter, he applied for compassionate appointment in plain paper on 09.12.2009 (Annexure C).					
	However, he had filed the pro-forma application on					
	24.01.2012 after getting the details of retiral benefit.					
	However, the respondents have rejected his claim on the					
	ground that he applied for compassionate appointment after					
	two years.					
	Being aggrieved with, he has filed the instant					
	application. The respondents have filed their reply and they

	compassionate appointment in 2009. The respondents have		
	denied and disputed the contention of the applicant and he		
	applied in plain paper on 09.12.2009. Since there is no		
	receiving seal in the said application. However, the		
	applicant had actually applied in prescribed pro-forma on		
	24.01.2012. Therefore, the respondents rightly rejected his		
	claim. No rejoinder has been filed by the applicant.		
	We have perused the records. It is noted that the		
	respondents had rejected the claim of the applicant that he		
	had approached the authority in 2012 only i.e. more than		
	two years from the date of death of his deceased mother		
	(employee). Even from the perusal of the said letter dated		
	09.12.2009 (Annexure C), it is noted that there is no receipt		
	or seal of respondents which was not even controverted by		
	the applicant by filing any rejoinder. We are agreeable with		
	the contention of the respondents. Therefore, we do not find		
	any reason to interfere with the impugned order.		
	Accordingly, the O.A. is dismissed being devoid of any		
	merit.
