	The applicant has prayed for direction upon the respondents to	
	grant him benefit of Modified Career Advancement Scheme (in	
	short, MCAS) for completion of 25 years of satisfactory service and	
	other consequential reliefs.	
	The applicant joined in the Government service on January 29,	
	1974 as Work Assistant. Subsequently, he appointed as Sub-	
	Assistant Engineer (SAE) on March 12, 1975 and was granted	
	benefit of Career Advancement Scheme (in short, CAS) for	
	completion of satisfactory service of 10 years and 20 years on April	
	1, 1989 and April 1, 1995 respectively. The contention of the	
	applicant is that he was not granted benefit of MCAS on	
	completion of satisfactory service of 25 years on March 11, 2000.	
	He retired from service on October 31, 2005 and got pension. The	
	grievance of the applicant is that he was not granted commuted	
	value of pension, leave encashment and benefit of MCAS for	
	completion of 25 years of satisfactory service.	
	Learned Counsel for the applicant contends that the applicant	
	completed 25 years of service on March 11, 2000 but the benefit of

	MCAS was not given even for completion of 25 years of satisfactory	
	service. He further submits that leave encashment was also not	
	granted in favour of the applicant for loss of service book.	
	However, he submits by placing a copy of revised PPO dated July	
	24, 2019 that he has already been given commuted value of	
	pension during pendency of the present application. On the other	
	hand, Mr. Ghosh, Learned Counsel representing the State	
	respondents contends that benefit of MCAS cannot be granted in	
	favour of the applicant as he got promotion in the higher post	
	before completion of 25 years of service. With regard to	
	disbursement of the leave encashment in favour of the applicant,	
	Mr. Ghosh submits that the issue of leave encashment is in process	
	and the same will disbursed in due course in favour of the	
	applicant.	
	Having heard Learned Counsel representing both parties and on	
	consideration of the materials on record, we find that the	
	commuted value of pension has already been given in favour of the	
	applicant at the time of issuance of revised pension on July 24,	
	2019. The materials on record indicate that the applicant got	
	benefit of CAS for completion of 20 years of service on April 1,	
	1995 and he got promotion to Grade I SAE on April 1, 1997 i.e.	
	before completion of 25 years of service on March 11, 2000. Since	
	the applicant got promotion before completion of 25 years of	
	service, he is not entitled to get the benefit of MCAS as prayed for.	
	With regard to the claim of the applicant for release of leave	
	encashment for 300 days of Earned Leave which was to his credit	
	on the date of superannuation, we are of the view that the
