	The instant application has been filed challenging the		
	impugned order dated 11.05.2015 whereby the prayer of the		
	applicant for compassionate appointment has been rejected		
	on the ground that the applicant had applied for the		
	compassionate appointment beyond two years as per the		
	Scheme of the department.		
	As per the applicant, the father of the applicant died on		
	29.09.2009. Thereafter the applicant applied on 01.08.2011		
	in prescribed pro-forma (Annexure B). However,		
	subsequently the respondent had rejected his claim on the		
	ground filing the application beyond the stipulated period of		
	time. However, as per the applicant, the respondent failed to		
	realise that the applicant is otherwise eligible for		
	employment. Therefore, he has prayed for quashing of the		
	impugned order dated 11.05.2015. The respondents have		
	filed reply today.

	As per the counsel for the respondent, his case has	
	been rightly rejected on the ground beyond the stipulated	
	period as the father of the applicant died in 2009 and he	
	applied for the compassionate appointment in 2011.	
	We have heard the counsel for the respondent and	
	perused the records. It is noted that the applicant himself	
	has admitted that he has applied for compassionate	
	appointment in 2011 whereas his father died in the year	
	2009. Therefore, it is settled principle of law that the case of	
	compassionate appointment is to be considered as per the	
	scheme of the department as the department has specific time	
	frame for considering the case of appointment and the main	
	purpose of the consideration of the case of compassionate	
	appointment is to support the sudden financial crisis of the	
	deceased employee. Therefore, as admittedly the applicant	
	has approached the respondent after considerable time.	
	Therefore, in our considered opinion, the respondents rightly	
	rejected the case of the applicant. We do not fine any merit	
	to entertain the instant O.A. Accordingly, the O.A. is	
	dismissed being devoid of any merit.
