	arrested vide order dated 14.05.1994. Thereafter, he was	
	served with a Charge Sheet dated 02.08.1994. Ultimately in	
	the disciplinary proceedings, he was punished with an order	
	of reversion from the post of S.I. to A.S.I vide Disciplinary	
	Authority's order dated 03.09.2004 and also retired from	
	the service on 30.09.2004. Subsequently he was acquitted	
	from the criminal case vide order dated 17.04.2008.	
	Thereafter he approached the Commissioner of Police,

	No reply has been filed. However, Mr. R.K. Mondal,

	stipulated period of time. Further, he had approached the									
	wrong authority. Therefore, his case should be dismissed.									
	Heard the parties and perused the records. It is noted									
	that the applicant was reverted from the post of S.I. to

	03.09.2004. However, he never challenged the said order									
	before the authority. In the meantime, he retired and was									
	subsequently acquitted from criminal case dated									
	17.04.2008. Even then he approached the authority in the									
	year 2014 only and that too as per the respondent before a									
	wrong forum. Therefore, as the applicant has already									
	accepted punishment order and even in this application,									
	after a long time he has approached the authority without
