in the year 2009, his client is not covered by the

notification dated 7th February, 2014 on which reliance

has been placed in the impugned order and

accordingly order may be passed.

Since, we find that on the date of notification dated 7th February, 2014 issued by the Finance Department (Audit Br.), Government of West Bengal, that the applicant had already attained the age of 50 years and performed more than 20 years of service and as a right has accrued in his favour under Rule 75 (aaa), the amended Rule 75(aaaa) is not applicable. Be it mentioned that an accrued right cannot be divested in the manner it has been done. Therefore, the impugned order appearing at page 62, being annexure R of this application, is set aside and quashed. The application is allowed.
