On April 12, 2013 the applicant submitted application in the manuscript form and thereafter application was submitted in the prescribed format which was forwarded by the District Magistrate, Cooch Behar to the respondent No. 5</p>

on February 26, 2013. The grievance of the applicant is that the respondent No. 5 has not yet processed the case of the applicant.

In view of the above back ground facts, we direct the respondent No. 5, Commissioner to the Government of West Bengal, Department of Panchayat & Rural Development to consider the case of the applicant as forwarded under letter dated November 26, 2013 by the District Magistrate, Cooch Behar (Annexure "F" to the original application) and to take a decision on the basis of materials available on record and in accordance with law and to take necessary follow up action within a period of twelve weeks from the date of communication of the order. The respondent No. 5 is further directed to communicate the result of the case of the applicant within a period of two weeks from the date of taking decision.

With the above direction, the original application is disposed of.
